ORDER GRANTING PARTIES' JOINT MOTION TO STAY CERTAIN CLAIMS AND COUNTERCLAIMS

On December 9, 2022, the Parties filed their Joint Motion to Stay Certain Claims and Counterclaims, in which they moved to stay the claims by The Thrasher Group Inc. ("Thrasher") and the counterclaims by Bear Contracting LLC ("Bear") (collectively the "Parties") related to the Blue Horizon Project¹ in this action.

In support, the Parties informed that, as to the First Count, Second Count, and Third Count of Thrasher's Complaint and Count One of Bear's Counterclaims, they had entered into a Conditional Settlement Agreement and Release of All Claims related to the Blue Horizon Project

The Blue Horizon Project is a project performed for the West Virginia Department of Highways ("WVDOH") and is formally designated as "Blue Horizon Dr. - PA St Ln" and Project Number S331-79-155.50 00, NFA-2117(035).

("Settlement Agreement"). The Settlement Agreement is conditional in nature and is dependent on certain conditions precedent occurring in the relatively near future, including certain actions by the WVDOH.

They further informed that the Settlement Agreement does not affect the Parties' remaining claims and counterclaims related to the two other projects at issue in their dispute and that they wished to proceed with their remaining claims related to the two other projects that are the subject of their dispute and are not requesting any changes to the current schedule established by the Court. Consequently, the Parties request that the Court stay their claims related to the Blue Horizon Project.

For reasons appearing to the Court, the Court GRANTS the Parties' joint motion and stays their respective claims related to the Blue Horizon Project.

It is so ORDERED.
