ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF CHARLESTON AREA MEDICAL CENTER, INC.'S
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITATION AND TO FILE REDACTED
OMNIBUS RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO PAC'S MOTION TO DISMISS
PLAINTIFF'S COMPLAINT AND TRAKE'S MOTION TO DISMISS PLAINTIFF'S
COMPLAINT

On a date prior, Plaintiff Charleston Area Medical Center, Inc. ("Plaintiff") properly moved this Court to enter an Order granting its Motion for Leave to Exceed Page Limitation and to File Redacted Omnibus Response in Opposition to PAC's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Trake's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Incorporated Memorandum of Law ("the Motion"). Having considered the Motion, and being otherwise duly advised, the Court FINDS that Plaintiff Charleston Area Medical Center, Inc.'s Omnibus Response in





Opposition to PAC's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Trake's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint ("Omnibus Response") reproduces substantial portions of the Complaint and multiple exhibits thereto, which this Court has already found to be subject to affirmative confidentiality obligations, as represented in the Motion. (See Order Granting Pl.'s Mot. Leave (entered July 13, 2022).) In view of its prior determination regarding the confidentiality of such information/material, the Court FURTHER FINDS that the UNREDACTED Omnibus Response, provided as Exhibit B to the Motion, must remain sealed indefinitely. In addition, the Court FINDS that good cause supports Plaintiff's request to exceed the applicable page limitation.

Being duly advised, the Court CONCLUDES that good cause supports the Motion and does HEREBY GRANT the same. Plaintiff is HEREBY GRANTED LEAVE to file its Omnibus Response in excess of the twenty (20) page limit.

In addition, Plaintiff is HEREBY GRANTED LEAVE to file its Omnibus Response WITH REDACTIONS. In that regard, the Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to file the REDACTED version of Plaintiff Charleston Area Medical Center, Inc.'s Omnibus Response in Opposition to PAC's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Trake's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint, which Plaintiff provided as Exhibit A to the Motion, forthwith. The REDACTED version of Plaintiff Charleston Area Medical Center, Inc.'s Omnibus Response in Opposition to PAC's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Trake's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Trake's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint SHALL BE made available to the public.

Furthermore, Plaintiff is HEREBY GRANTED LEAVE to file an UNREDACTED version of Plaintiff Charleston Area Medical Center, Inc.'s Omnibus Response in Opposition to PAC's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Trake's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's

Complaint UNDER SEAL. In that regard, the Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to file the UNREDACTED version of Plaintiff Charleston Area Medical Center, Inc.'s Omnibus Response in Opposition to PAC's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Trake's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint, which Plaintiff provided as Exhibit B to the Motion, UNDER SEAL.

The Clerk of the Court is **FURTHER DIRECTED** to send a certified copy of this Order to counsel of record.
