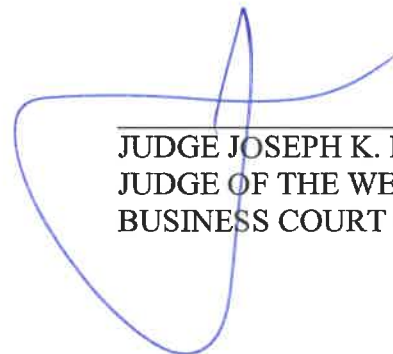
That movant will provide a proposed order (if not already done) and serve a copy upon all non-moving parties. Non-moving parties shall file written responses and proposed orders

Thereafter, the Court will rule upon the motion on the pleadings and record or schedule a hearing if the Court deems it necessary.
