ORDER

UPON CONSIDERATION of the parties' *Joint Stipulation* related to a misunderstanding by Plaintiff, Defendants stipulated that their expert, Dr. David W. Sykora, will be made available on March 7, 2023, for his deposition, which is seven (7) days past the discovery deadline.

Additionally, the parties mutually agreed to extend the deadline for the filing of dispositive motions by seven (7) days to March 22, 2022. Responses are to be filed within fifteen (15) days of the motions and replies will be filed within eleven (11) days of the responses.

WHEREFORE, the Court **ORDERS** that the *Scheduling Order for Fraud Claims* entered September 6, 2022 be amended to extend the deadline to file dispositive motions to March 22, 2023.
