## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

It is further ORDERED that McDowell County is declared the county of origin in this matter and that any members of the Division assigned to this matter by Judge Wilkes are authorized pursuant to Article VIII § 3 of the West Virginia Constitution and Trial Court Rule 29.07(b) to preside over the above-referenced case in McDowell County.

It is finally ORDERED that a copy of this ORDER be transmitted to the Central Office of the Division; the Honorable Christopher C. Wilkes; the Honorable John A. Hutchison, Judge of the Tenth Judicial Circuit; the Honorable Rudolph J. Murensky, II, Judge of the Eighth Judicial Circuit; to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Raleigh County; and to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of McDowell County, who is to provide copies of the same to all parties of record or their counsel.
