The bidding process for third-tier media rights is just one example of the issues that arise in this matter. This action presents matters that should be resolved in a judicious and timely manner.

Yesterday our team met to review and assign tasks for the prosecution of these claims. We also further considered the proposed "formal" assignment of these proceedings to the Business Court pursuant to Trial Court Rule 29.

After careful consideration, it is our preference that we continue on our current track, without the imposition of time constraints imposed by Trial Court Rule 29. Many factors have influenced this decision, including (1) that, at this point, we are unable to determine when we will have complete copies of the WVU Purchasing files for both 900027802X and 90003005, and until that point, cannot fully evaluate the competing proposals; (2) the magnitude of the anticipated discovery to further substantiate many of the predicate facts set forth in the Amended and Supplemental Complaint; and (3) the complexity of the case, particularly considering the multiple parties involved.

Dear Judge Evans:

I write to respond to your inquiry of the parties during the hearing on August 26, 2013, regarding referral of this matter to the Business Court. West Virginia University Foundation favors such a referral. This matter has some significant commercial issues in terms of the University's procurement process and the specialized nature of the media rights market underlying the dispute which make referral to the Business Court appropriate. Of equal importance from the Foundation's perspective is the expedited process available through the Business Court to resolve the case.

For decades, the WVU Athletic Department has been tasked by University administrators to be self-supporting. The revenues generated from the football and basketball programs by the Athletic Department and generous annual support from private donors make self-sufficiency an attainable goal. From the student perspective, these revenue sources provide the opportunity to participate in a wide range of non-revenue sports. The complaint lodged by the West Virginia Radio Corp. as an unsuccessful bidder for a portion of the mediarights package challenges the procurement processes employed by the Athletic Department.

¹ In the context of the University's mandate to the Athletic Department to operate on a self-supporting basis, good stewardship required Athletic Department administrators to recognize that the Department's 20th Century, no-bid radio broadcast contract with West Virginia Radio Corporation deprived the Athletic Department of a substantial revenue stream available to the Department in a 21st Century media environment.

To support its challenge, West Virginia Radio Corp. makes many yet-to-be-proven allegations assaulting the actions, character and good faith of numerous individuals involved in the operation of the Athletic Department. As the court has recognized, allegations of this character, even though unproven, are harmful both to the individuals involved and to the public's confidence in the University's management. These allegations also have the potential to undermine confidence among donors whose continued support is important to my client's success in fulfilling its mission of support to West Virginia University. For these reasons, this case should be adjudicated as quickly as reasonably possible through the Business Court.

At the hearing held on August 26, 2013, the Court requested that West Virginia University Board of Governors ["WVU"] communicate its position on possible transfer of the above-captioned matter to the Business Court Division under Rule 29 of the Trial Court Rules and to do so by today.

WVU defers to the Court's discretion in deciding whether referral to the Business Court Division under Trial Court Rule 29.06 should occur. WVU notes that Your Honor will continue to preside over this action regardless of the choice and that the Court will have the authority to fashion an appropriate schedule for disposition of the matter under either Trial Court Rule 29.08 or West Virginia Rule of Civil Procedure 16.

I was copied on Mr. Simmerman's letter of August 29, 2013, wherein West Virginia Radio Corporation ["WVRC"] advised the Court of its position on transfer to the Business Court Division. I must dispute any contention by WVRC that WVU has failed to provide complete copies of the purchasing files for both RFP 900027802X or RFP 90003005 and that such an assertion can serve as a basis for opposing referral to the Business Court Division. WVU has fully met its obligations under FOIA and has produced the purchasing files for both RFP's, subject to appropriate statutory exemptions.
