- 2. There is no genuine issue of material fact relevant to the Defendants' respective liability on the various instruments and documents that form the basis for United's complaint, all as detailed in the Motions.
- 3. Accordingly, each of the Defendants owes to United an amount of money, to be determined by this Court, under the various instruments and documents that form the basis for United's complaint, all as detailed in the Motions.

Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motions are **GRANTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that each of the Defendants, jointly and severally, owes to United an amount of money to be determined by subsequent order of this Court.
