**ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY MOTION TO CONTINUE**  
**AND ORDER OF GENERAL CONTINUANCE**

On July 22, 2015, Defendant CTL Engineering of West Virginia, Inc. filed its "Emergency Motion to Continue July 29, 2015 Mediation to Continue Trial and for Amended Scheduling Order," seeking a continuance of the judicial mediation scheduled for July 29, 2015, a continuance of the trial scheduled for September 15, 2015 and the entry of a new Scheduling Order. (2) the judicial mediation previously scheduled for July 29, 2015 shall be, and is, hereby **CONTINUED** to October 13, 2015 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the West Virginia State Bar Center in Northgate Business Park, 2000 Deitrick Boulevard, Charleston, West Virginia;

(3) the deadlines set forth in the "Scheduling Order" entered on September 29, 2014 shall be, and are, hereby **VACATED** and the Court will subsequently enter a separate Amended Scheduling Order;

(4) the trial date of September 15, 2015 shall be, and is, hereby **CONTINUED** and the Court will subsequently schedule a new trial date in a subsequent Amended Scheduling Order; and

(5) this case shall be, and is, **GENERALLY CONTINUED** until further order of the Court.


