Accordingly, in the interest of judicial economy and to avoid inconvenience, unnecessary cost, and duplicative discovery, this Court ORDERS that all discovery completed and exchanged in the Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania case, Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. v. The Velotta Company, Court of Comm. Pls. Case No.: 13CI05950, is hereby incorporated into the above captioned case, without duplication, with the exception of discovery conducted without notice to Plaintiff's West Virginia counsel. Counsel remains obligated to cooperate with scheduling and venue of the instant case and shall provide notice as to all written discovery served and consulted as to the scheduling of depositions.

THEREFORE, upon the record and pertinent legal authorities, the Court rules that the Motion is GRANTED.
