## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW AND RESCHEDULING HEARING ON MOTION TO APPOINT SPECIAL RECIEVER

This matter came before the Court pursuant to the Motion to Withdraw of Defendants'

Counsel. On or about March 14, 2016, came Melissa Eakle Leasure, James R. Bailes and the law
firm of Bailes, Craig & Yon, PLLC, and moved this Court to enter an Order permitting said

counsel to withdraw from representing the Defendants in the present action. Based upon Counsels' proffer that a conflict has arisen and that the continued representation of Defendants would result in a violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct, and upon review of the client termination letter attached to the motion as exhibit A, the Court finds that the movants have complied with Trial Court Rule 4.03 and finds good cause to grant Counsel's Motion to Withdraw.

Taking into consideration that many of the Defendants are precluded from self-representation by virtue of being artificial entities created by law, and for that reason required to act through duly licensed attorneys in legal matters, the Court delays and RESCHEDULES the Wednesday, March 23, 2016 hearing on the Peoples Bank, National Association's Revised Motion to Appoint Special Receiver, to Wednesday, March 30, 2016, at 1:00 p.m., prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the Court shall permit. The hearing shall be conducted at the Kanawha County Courthouse, 111 Court Street, Charleston, WV 25301. In order to argue any opposition to said Motion, Defendants that are precluded from appearing *pro se* under Trial Court Rule 4.03 must appear with prepared duly-licensed counsel.

THEREFORE, the Court hereby GRANTS the Motion to Withdraw of Defendants'
Counsel and ORDERS Melissa Eakle Leasure, James R. Bailes and the law firm of Bailes, Craig & Yon, PLLC, to forward Defendants this Order with a letter explaining to the Defendants the effective date of the withdrawal; that all pleadings, notices, and other papers will be served on the parties directly by mail at the last known address of the party until new counsel enters an appearance; and that certain Defendants will be precluded from making any oral or written argument without new counsel. Furthermore, withdrawing counsel will provided the Circuit Clerk of Cabell County, West Virginia, a list of each Defendant's last known address.

South Street, Suite 2100, Martinsburg, West Virginia, 25401; all counsel of record; and and the law firm of Bailes, Craig & Yon, PLLC.
