**ORDER FOLLOWING STATUS CONFERENCE**

On a previous day the Court had been informed that the parties reached a settlement regarding the substantive issues in the above captioned case, but that minor issues remained which prevented the parties from submitting a proposed dismissal order. Furthermore, the Court was notified that a party terminated representation, but that the docket failed to reflect a motion to withdraw. Accordingly, the Court set and held a status conference on August 8, 2016, in order to clarify the issues and set the case for trial or remove the case from the active docket.


During the hearing, counsel for the parties explained that only a Featherlite trailer and laptop stood between the effective resolution of the case. Parties explained that an agreement had been made, but not effectively executed.

Therefore, the Court ORDERED, and memorializes herein, that within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order , the parties shall either set a mediation with the Resolution Judge, as requested, or file and set for hearing before the Presiding Judge, a motion to enforce settlement.
