The above-captioned case was referred to the Business Court Division on July 31, 2017, by the Honorable Allen H. Loughry II, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia. This matter is related but not consolidated with other similar cases throughout the state. Many of these cases are in the process of briefing and weighing a Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Timely Perfect Appeal.

Therefore, in the interest of judicial economy, the Court finds it appropriate to delay this case's initial scheduling and case management conference until the referenced Motions to Dismiss can be resolved.

The Court inquired with all counsel of record and permitted ample opportunity for objection.
