SCHEDULING ORDER

the Court will rule upon the motion on the pleadings and the record or schedule a hearing if the
Court deems it necessary. The original proposed orders and copies of motions and/or
memoranda shall be sent directly to the Judge. Copies of the proposed orders and the original

motions and memoranda shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court. The Court will not consider motion until proposed orders are received.


