ORDER

Mullens, all for hearing on the Defendants' "Motion to Hear Defendant's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment Held in Abeyance," and Defendants' "Motion to Implead Third-Party Defendant and File Defendants' First Amended Answer to Complaint and Counterclaim."

The Court after considering the pleadings filed herein, the arguments of counsel, and all matters of record, the Court hereby denies Defendants' "Motion to Implead Third-Party Defendant and File Defendants' First Amended Answer to Complaint and Counterclaim," at this time and

further denies in part and grants in part Defendants' "Motion to Hear Defendants' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment Held in Abeyance," and further FINDS as follows:

The Plaintiff's Complaint does not meet the particularity required to plead a cause of action for fraud, and also, that Defendants, likewise, do not at this time, have facts sufficient to plead a cause of action for fraud against Rhonda Marcum, individually.

WHEREFORE, this Court hereby ORDERS the following:

- The Plaintiff has ten (10) business days from the hearing date to attempt to amend its
 Complaint to plead facts sufficient to sustain a cause of action for fraud with the required
 particularity;
- If the Defendants develop facts sufficient to plead the required particularity for fraud, they
 may renew their motion setting forth said facts;
- 3. The Defendants' "Motion to Implead Third-Party Defendant and File Defendants' First Amended Answer to Complaint and Counterclaim" is hereby denied, unless and until they develop additional facts as set forth above;
- 4. The Defendants' "Motion to Hear Defendants' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment Held in Abeyance" is granted in regards to the Plaintiff's Fraud claim as set forth above, but otherwise denied at this time; and
- The Parties may further file any motions they deem necessary as this matter proceeds and schedule the same pursuant to the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure.
