ORDER: GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DISMISS AND MOTION TO STRIKE ALLEGATIONS OF FRAUD

On October 4, 2018, came Plaintiff, Stollings Trucking, Inc., by and through counsel, Scott H. Kaminski, Kaminski Law, PLLC, and Defendants, Continuum Coal, LLC, GS Energy, LLC, Ian Ganzer, and Gary Ganzer, by and through counsel, Hunter B. Mullens, Mullens & Mullens, PLLC, all for a hearing on "Defendants' Motion to Dismiss and Motion to Strike Allegations of Fraud."

The Court, after considering the pleadings filed herein, the arguments of counsel, and all matters of record, hereby GRANTS "Defendants' Motion to Dismiss and Motion to Strike Allegations of Fraud," and further FINDS as follows:

The allegations contained in Plaintiff's Amended Complaint do not meet the particularity required to plead a cause of action for fraud, and Plaintiff alleges no other causes of actions against Defendants Ian Ganzer and Gary Ganzer.

WHEREFORE, this Court hereby ORDERS the following:

- 1. Count 2: Fraud of Plaintiff's Complaint, and of Plaintiff's Amended Complaint, is dismissed;
- 2. Paragraphs seventeen (17) through twenty-seven (27) and twenty-nine (29) through thirty-eight (38) of Plaintiff's *Amended Complaint* are stricken; and
- 3. Defendants Ian Ganzer and Gary Ganzer are dismissed from this civil action.

 The objections and exceptions by the Plaintiff to this Order are preserved for the record.
