AMENDED ORDER RESCHEDULING THE MEDIATION DEADLINE

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the mediation deadline shall be vacated and shall be rescheduled to a date to be determined by the parties and the Resolution Judge at the telephonic conference scheduled before the Resolution Judge on January 4, 2019. Other than the mediation deadline, the Court's previously entered Scheduling Order shall remain in full force and effect.
