ORDER ON MOTION TO CONTINUE AND AMENDED TIMEFRAME ORDER

On April 5, 2019, came the parties by and through counsel for a hearing on the previously filed *Plaintiff's Motion to Continue Trial*. Upon a review of the Plaintiff's motion, the parties' response and reply briefs, and arguments of counsel, the Court does hereby rule as follows:

1. Plaintiff's Motion to Continue Trial is **DENIED**. Trial in this matter, which is currently set for Tuesday May 7, 2019, shall commence at said time.

2. The Court does hereby **ORDER** that its March 20, 2019 *Timeframe Order* be **AMENDED** as follows:

a. Plaintiff shall produce reports setting forth supplemental or amended expert opinions, and the basis therefore, if any, by **April 22, 2019**; and


b. Defendant shall produce reports setting forth supplemental, amended, or rebuttal expert opinions, and the basis therefore, if any, by **April 30, 2019**.

c. Both parties shall file and serve pre-trial memoranda, including disclosure of trial witnesses that the respective party a) intends to call, and b) may call if the need arises by April 30, 2019.



The Clerk is directed to mail copies of this Order to all parties of record. The Plaintiff is saved his objections to the Court's Order.


