ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO EXTEND PLAINTIFFS' EXPERT DISCLOSURE DEADLINE

On a previous day came the Plaintiffs, by counsel, pursuant to Plaintiffs' Motion to Extend Plaintiffs' Expert Disclosure Deadline ("Motion") and moved this Court for an Order extending plaintiffs' expert disclosure deadline, currently set for June 21, 2019. Plaintiffs' Motion is predicated upon their assertions that they need appropriate time to review Defendants' responses to Plaintiffs' discovery requests prior to making their expert disclosures. Plaintiffs had served those discovery requests upon Defendants approximately eight (8) months ago. Finally, Plaintiffs argue that they will be prejudiced if the expert disclosure deadline is not extended to allow them to properly review the Defendants' discovery responses prior to filing their disclosures.

The Court, being of the opinion that the Plaintiffs' Motion is well founded in law and in fact, does hereby ORDER, ADJUDGE, and DECREE as follows:

1. The Jury Trial Scheduling Order entered on March 18, 2019 is amended as it pertains to the disclosure of experts.

- 2. Plaintiffs shall have thirty (30) days from the date Defendants inform Plaintiffs that they have provided full answers to discovery or the Court-ordered resolution of any discovery disputes, whichever is later, but in no event shall Plaintiffs file their Expert Disclosures less than 90 days prior to the discovery completion date.
- 3. Defendants will have thirty (30) days from receipt of Plaintiffs' expert disclosures to file their expert disclosures.
- 4. Plaintiffs will have thirty (30) days from receipt of Defendants' expert disclosures to file their rebuttal expert disclosures.

The clerk is directed to provide copies of this order to counsel of record.
