
It is ORDERED pursuant to Rule 22 of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules as follows:
That movant will provide a proposed order (if not already done) and serve a copy upon all non-moving parties. Non-moving parties shall file written responses and proposed orders within 14

days of the entry of this order, if desired, and serve copies of the same on the moving party. The movant may thereafter file rebuttal memoranda, if desired, within 7 calendar days of the filing of any response. Thereafter, the Court will rule upon the motion on the pleadings and record or schedule a hearing if the Court deems it necessary.
