## ORDER REGARDING PROCEDURE FOR DISCOVERY DISPUTES

As an initial matter, the Court notes that all discovery disputes have been referred to the Discovery Commissioner pursuant to the Order Referring All Discovery Disputes to Discovery Commissioner entered on March 22 2021. To ensure continuity and timely review of Discovery Disputes, the Court ORDERS the following procedures shall apply:

- 1. The parties shall meet and confer in a good faith effort to resolve the dispute.
- 2. If the dispute is not resolved and a discovery motion is filed by a party:

a. A written response in opposition to the motion shall be filed no later than fifteen

(15) business days after submission of the motion; and

b. Any written reply in further support of the motion shall be filed no later than seven

(7) business days after submission of the written opposition to the motion.

c. Each party shall submit a proposed order within findings of fact and conclusions of

law to the Discovery Commissioner. The moving party shall submit its Order with the filing of

the motion. The responding party shall submit its Order with the filing of its response. All

proposed orders shall be submitted in Word form.

All papers shall be submitted to Discovery Commissioner Russell M. Clawges, Jr. and

served by email upon all counsel. Upon completion of the briefing schedule set out above, the

moving party shall provide hard copies of all submissions by overnight mail or courier to: Russell

M. Clawges, Jr. To the extent that electronic exhibits to the motion and/or briefing papers are

voluminous, the moving party will seek direction from the Discovery Commissioner regarding the

need for such voluminous exhibits to be provided in hard copy.

The Discovery Commissioner will notify the parties if he would like oral argument on any

motion. In such case, the moving party shall arrange for a court reporter and for any hearing

(telephonic or otherwise) to be recorded and later transcribed.
