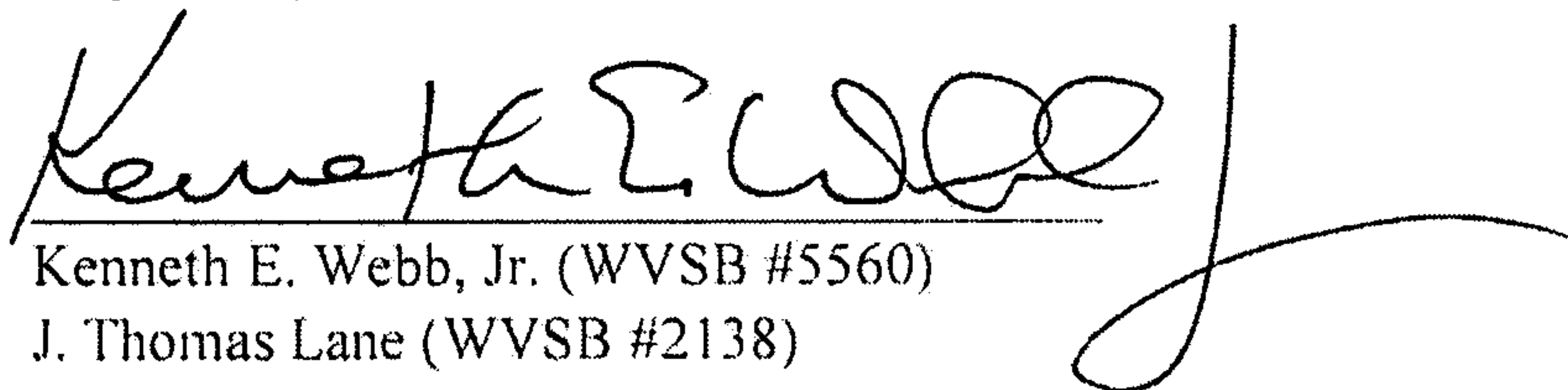
The objections and exceptions of Plaintiffs and Appalachian Power Company are noted and preserved.
