

Intermediate Court of Appeals Issues First Signed Opinion and Memorandum Decisions

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – On Friday, November 18, 2022, the Intermediate Court of Appeals of West Virginia (ICA) issued its first signed opinion. The Court issued its opinion in *Amanda C. v. Christopher P.*, 22-ICA-2, authored by Chief Judge Daniel W. Greear and joined in by Judge Charles O. Lorensen. Judge Thomas E. Scarr filed a concurring opinion.
