This lawyer misappropriated his client's funds to support his drug problem. He has since sought treatment and has straightened up his life. An indefinite suspension with the right to petition the Court for reinstatement in three years provides plenty of protection to the public.

I respectfully feel that annulling this la wyer's license is not an appropriate sanction under the circum stances. The Hearing Panel Subcom mittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board heard the evidence, considered the demanor of the witnesses and of Mr. Brown, and made a careful, measured recommendation. I amnot persuaded by the majority opinion's reasoning that the recommendations of the Board should be so lightly dismissed.

I therefore dissent.
