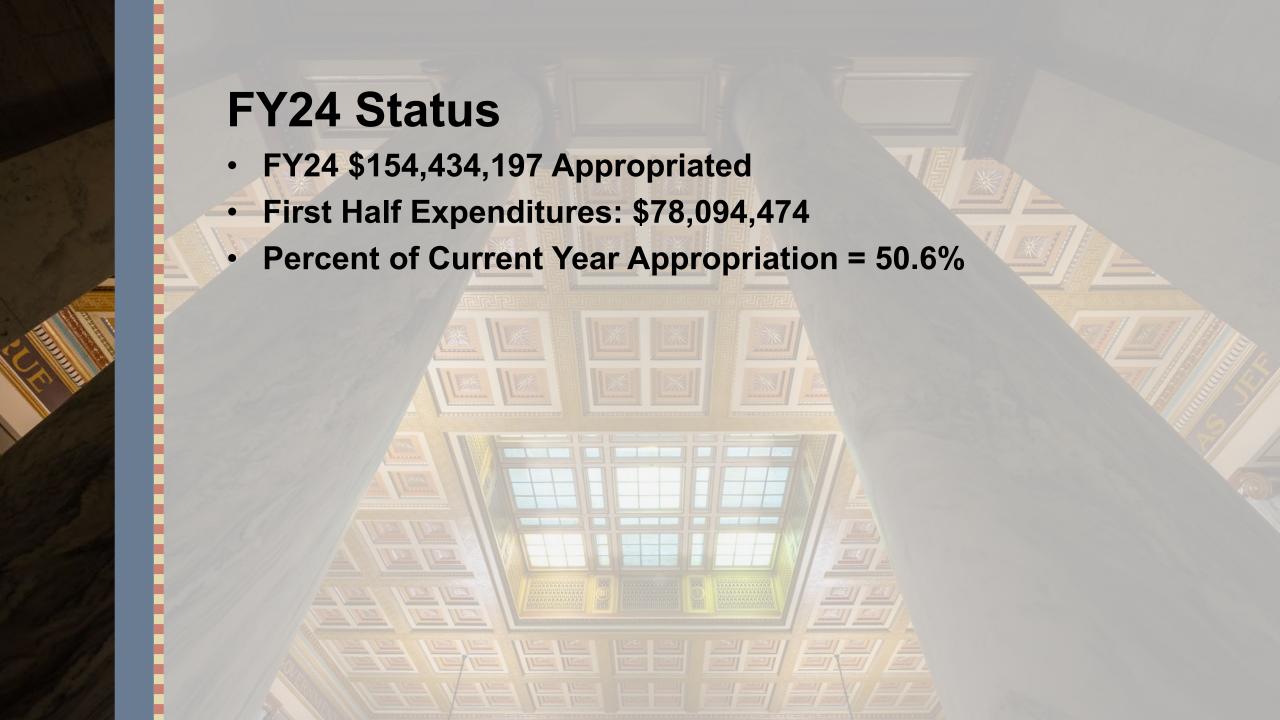

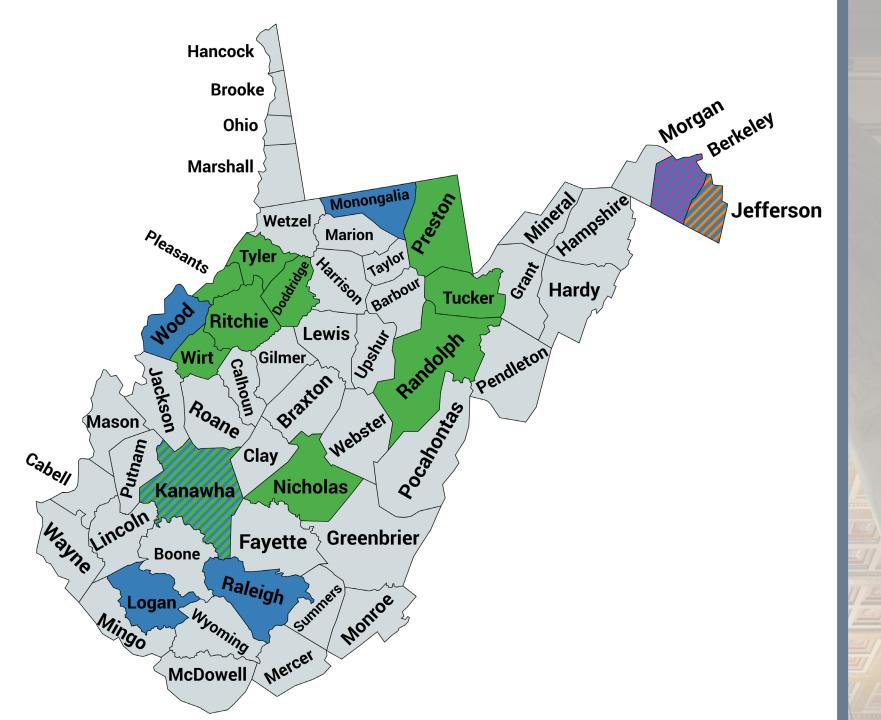




FY25 Request Overview:

FY24 and FY25 Comparison

\$5,810,757 difference

Highlights:

- \$2,480,411 increase in PEIA employer premiums (2023 SB 268)
- \$2,067,575 increase due to 2023 HB 3332 (Judicial Realignment)
 - Half-year salary and benefits for 20 new FTEs in Circuit Court, 3 new FTEs in Family Court, 20 new FTEs in Magistrate Court
- \$620,182 for 8 new probation positions
- \$170,881 for 3 new positions (2 facilities management & 1 civics education/outreach)
- \$379,000 increase in Judicial Retirement System
