ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION FO MODIFY SCHEDULING ORDER

This matter came before the Court this // day of December 2023, upon Defendant Jeffrey Isner's Motion to Modify Scheduling Order. The Court hereby MODIFIES the May 15, 2023 Scheduling Order. The Trial set for January 16, 2024 is CONTINUED. The Pretrial Conference set for December 28, 2023 is CONTINUED. The deadline for the exchange of the final witness list is also hereby continued.

All other deadlines contained in the May 15, 2023 Scheduling Order remain in full force and effect, including the requirement that pre-trial conference memoranda, motions *in limine*, and proposed jury instructions and voir dire be submitted no later than ten days before the pre-trial conference.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the pretrial conference shall be rescheduled to February 28, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. and the Jury Trial shall be rescheduled to March 18, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. Further, the deadline for the final witness list to be exchanged shall be February 21, 2024.
