**Agreed Order Dismissing Claims Between Plaintiff and
Defendants/Counterclaimants TAMCO Capital Corporation and Anthony Rome**

On a prior day came the Plaintiff Community Care of West Virginia, Inc. ("CCWV") and the Defendants/Counterclaimants TAMCO Capital Corporation ("TAMCO") and Anthony Rome, by their respective counsel, and announced to the Court that, pursuant to Rule 41 of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure, CCWV has agreed to voluntarily dismiss its claims against TAMCO and Anthony Rome with prejudice and that TAMCO and Anthony Rome have each agreed to voluntarily dismiss its/his counterclaim against CCWV with prejudice.

Pursuant to the representations of counsel for these parties, it is therefore **ORDERED** that CCWV's claims against TAMCO and Anthony Rome and that TAMCO's and Anthony Rome's counterclaims against CCWV are **DISMISSED, with prejudice**. It is further **ORDERED** that TAMCO and Anthony Rome are **DISMISSED, with prejudice**, from this case and that the case-style shall reflect the dismissal of TAMCO and Anthony Rome as parties in this action. Each party is to bear its/his own costs and attorney's

fees incurred during the pendency of this civil action.
