Supreme Court to Judge WVU Law School Moot Court

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – The Supreme Court of Appeals will judge the West Virginia University College of Law Baker Cup Moot Court appellate advocacy competition at 1 p.m. Tuesday, April 16, in the Supreme Court Courtroom in Charleston.

Since 1982, the competition has been open to all second-year law students, who must write an appellate brief and present oral arguments on both sides of the issue. The two finalists argue before the Supreme Court, and the justices rule on the appellate advocacy skills of the two students.

The two finalists this year are Katherine Whittington and Tyler Keller.
