DAY ORDER FROM MAY 6, 2024 HEARING

CAME the parties, in a Status Conference on May, 6, 2024, commencing at 1:30 p.m. via Microsoft Teams. Marvin W. Masters, Esq. appeared for Plaintiff, Southern Jackson Public Service District, David K. Hendrickson, Esq. appeared for Defendant, Master Meter, Inc., William R. Slicer, Esq. appeared for Defendant, Ferguson Enterprises, LLC, Daniel J. Konrad, Esq. and Matthew L. Ward, Esq. appeared for Defendant, C.J. Hughes Construction Company, and Jennifer N. Taylor, Esq. appeared for Defendant, Tri-State Pipeline, Inc.

1. Counsel provided the undersigned an update on the alternative process they are engaged into effectuate a resolution of this civil action. The parties agreed the stay of this Court's consideration of the pending discovery disputes and fee petition while they pursue this track should be continued to save the expense of pursuing a discovery track simultaneously with this resolution track. Counsel averred they are engaging Charles S. Piccirillo, Esq. as mediator in this matter and have obtained dates to mediate with him in June and/or July 2024. All counsel agreed to the use of Mr. Piccirillo as

mediator.

2. All counsel averred their agreement to this alternative track for resolution of this matter, and to a stay of the consideration of the aforementioned pending issues.
3. The undersigned, considering the agreement of all counsel, agreed to stay consideration of the pending discovery issues for a period of sixty days, or longer if needed.
4. The undersigned set this matter for status conference on July 29, 2024 at 1:30 p.m. via Microsoft Teams, at which time the parties will report as to the effectiveness of the alternative resolution route and advise the undersigned if more time is needed or if an amendment to the scheduling order is needed.
5. Counsel proffered they had no other matters to take up today.
6. The hearing was then adjourned.
