Re: Proposed Amendments to the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure

ORDER

In 2019, the Court established a committee to review the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure. On August 13, 2021, the committee submitted its proposed amendments to the Court. On June 15, 2022, the proposed amendments were published for a ninety-day period of public comment. By order entered on August 18, 2022, the public comment period was extended thirty days, until October 13, 2022.

Upon receipt and review of the comments, the Court has determined it will hear oral argument on the proposed amendments to Rule 23(i), Rule 26, and Rule 56 of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure. Oral argument is scheduled on Wednesday, March 29, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. The individuals and organizations that filed comments on Rule 23(i), Rule 26, or Rule 56 are invited to appear and present oral argument at that time. The Clerk of Court will provide those individuals and organizations with a Notice of Argument containing further information. Those individuals and organizations are encouraged to collaborate on their presentations of oral argument so as to preclude repetition.
