ORDER FROM JULY 25, 2022 HEARING

On the 25th day of July, 2022, came the plaintiff, Amanda F. Stewart, Individually and/or in her Administratrix of the Estate of John D. Stewart, Jr., by and through her counsel, Chad C. Groome and Angotti & Straface, L.C., and came the defendants, Monongalia County Commission and John Doe Deputy, by and through its counsel, Nathaniel D. Griffith and Pullin, Fowler, Flanagan Brown & Poe, PLLC, for a hearing on *Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Amended Complaint for Wrongful Death*.

The Court, having entertained the positions and arguments of counsel, both orally and as contained in the various briefs of the parties, hereby finds as follows:

- The defendants' Motion to Dismiss Counts I, II, and III of the Amended Complaint for Wrongful
 Death is hereby DENIED for those reasons previously articulated by the Court in regard to the
 defendants' Motion to Dismiss filed in reference to the original Complaint for Wrongful Death;
- 2. The defendants' Motion to Dismiss, to the extent that it relates to the defense of "qualified immunity," is hereby **DENIED** for those reasons previously articulated by the Court in regard to the defendants' Motion to Dismiss filed in reference to the original Complaint for Wrongful Death;
- 3. The defendants' Motion to Dismiss, to the extent that it relates to the issue of punitive damages, is hereby DENIED for those reasons previously articulated by the Court in regard to the

defendants' Motion to Dismiss filed in reference to the original Complaint for Wrongful Death. As previously held, the Court will determine the propriety of punitive damages in this case at a later time; and

4. Lastly, the plaintiff advised the Court that the claim for tort of outrage as set forth in the Amended Complaint for Wrongful Death at Count IV is WITHDRAWN and DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE. Accordingly, the defendants' Motion to Dismiss with respect to the tort of outrage claim (Count IV) is MOOT.

It is so **ORDERED**.

Objections and exceptions are saved.
