Geoffrey Bracken, Esq., Vi T. Tran, Esq., and Joseph G. Nogay, Esq., appeared for Plaintiffs BB Land, LLC and JB Exploration 1, LLC, and Brian R. Swiger, Esq. and John A. Budig, Esq. appeared for Defendants, Blackrock Enterprises, LLC and Michael L. Benedum. Conference was had as to the status of this case upon remand from the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals.

- Counsel for Plaintiff averred their position is that the Court should first determine whether a mining partnership exists, see what discovery, if any, is needed, and that the remedies and damages should be decided by the Court.
- 2. Counsel for Defendants averred there would be new, related cases filed which counsel would move for consolidation into the instant civil action, regarding claims of washout and minimization of damages that Defendants allege to have occurred at a time after the conclusion of the trial in this matter.
- 3. Counsel for Defendants also averred that the parties wish to mediate. Counsel for Plaintiffs confirmed that both parties are amenable to mediation. Discussion was had

regarding the use of a private mediator and/or Resolution Judge Wilkes.
