- The Court entered multiple orders on December 10, 2024, including a Final Judgment Order.
- 2. In the Final Judgment Order, the Court awarded monetary damages to Plaintiffs in the amount of \$2,150,000, plus pre-judgment and post-judgment interest at the relevant statutory rate(s).
- 3. Plaintiffs and Defendants may each appeal the Final Judgment Order and/or other orders entered by the Court in this action. The parties agree, and the Court **ORDERS** that, execution of the Final Judgment Order is stayed through and including January 21, 2025. The parties agree to this execution stay to allow time to finalize proper conditions for Defendants to post an appeal bond or alternative agreed security which, when finalized, will stay enforcement pending the outcome of the appellate process pursuant to West Virginia Rule of Civil Procedure 62(i).

- 4. Any agreement finalizing conditions for the security of Plaintiffs shall be without prejudice to the appeals of the respective parties.
- 5. This stay extension may be further extended by agreement of the parties and/or by order of the Court.
- 6. This is entered pursuant to the Court's discretionary authority under Rule 62 of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 28 of the West Virginia Rules of Appellate Procedure.
