AMENDMENT TO ELECTRONIC FILING
AND SERVICE CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Court's *Amendment to Electronic Filing and Service Case Management Order* (Transaction ID 60842949) is hereby amended as follows:

If a party is ADDING A DEFENDANT OR THIRD-PARTY DEFENDANT:

- If a party is adding a defendant or defendants and the \$15 fee authorized by West Virginia Code § 59-1-11(a)(7) to name additional defendants has been assessed and paid in Court Plus, select the document type **“Complaint - Amended to add defendant(s) – fee(s) paid”** and attach a copy of the Receipt from Court Plus for fee(s) paid with the filing.
- If a party is adding a third-party defendant or third-party defendants and the \$15 fee authorized by West Virginia Code § 59-1-11(a)(7) to name additional third-party defendants has been assessed and paid in Court Plus, select the document type **“Complaint – 3rd Party Amended to add 3rd party defendant(s) - fee(s) paid”** and attach a copy of the Receipt from Court Plus for fee(s) paid with the filing.
- Remember to link the amended complaint or amended third-party complaint to the Court's order granting the party's motion to amend using the “linked documents” feature in File & Serve*Xpress*.
- DO NOT use the multi-case filing feature to add a defendant or third-party defendant.
- DO NOT file more than one pleading adding a defendant or third-party defendant per transaction.

All other provisions of the Court's *Electronic Filing and Service Case Management Order* (Transaction ID 55746143) and *Amendment to Electronic Filing and Service Cases Management Order* (Transaction ID 60842949) remain in full force and effect.
