

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
SUPREME COURT OF APPEALS OF WEST VIRGINIA**

**RE: APPOINTMENT OF THE HONORABLE JENNIFER F. BAILEY TO THE
BUSINESS COURT DIVISION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 29.02 of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules, the Business Court Division may consist “of up to seven (7) active or senior status circuit court judges who shall be appointed by the Chief Justice, with the approval of the Supreme Court of Appeals. Each appointment is for a term of seven (7) years.”

WHEREAS, the Honorable Maryclaire Akers, Judge of the Eighth Judicial Circuit, has resigned from the Business Court Division. Her term expires on December 31, 2028. The Chief Justice has appointed, and the Court has approved, the Honorable Jennifer F. Bailey, Judge of the Eighth Judicial Circuit, to fill the remainder of Judge Akers’ term on the Business Court Division. Justices Bunn and Ewing would not approve the appointment.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Honorable Jennifer F. Bailey, Judge of the Eighth Judicial Circuit, be, and she hereby is, appointed to serve under the provisions of Rule 29 of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules through December 31, 2028.
