Resentencing Order from Hearing Held March 29, 2023

ON THIS the 29th day of March, 2023, came the State of West Virginia, by its Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, Donald C. Wandling; the Defendant, Paul Conley, and with counsel, Gerald Mercurio; pursuant to this date and time having previously been scheduled for a motions hearing for Resentencing.

WHEREFORE, Counsel for the Defendant moved the Court to resentence the Defendant for purposes of perfecting an appeal.

WHEREUPON, upon consideration of the representations of Counsel, a review of the file, and the Defendant's written motion, it is hereby ADJUDGED and ORDERED as follows:

1. That the Defendant's Motion for Resentencing is hereby GRANTED.
2. Pursuant to the Defendant's guilty plea to Count One, the Defendant is sentenced to not less than three (3) nor more than fifteen (15) years in the custody of the West Virginia Department of Corrections.
3. The Defendant is assessed a fine of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) upon this charge.
4. That a Judgment shall be filed against the Defendant for the costs of the funeral and burial services for Beverly Duty, civil damages and punitive damages as well on this charge.
5. The Defendant shall receive credit for time served on this charge.
6. Pursuant to the Defendant's guilty plea to Count Two, the Defendant is sentenced to not less than two (2) nor more than ten (10) years in the custody of the West Virginia Department of Corrections.

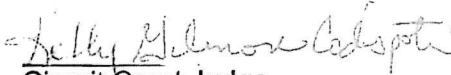
7. The Defendant is assessed a fine in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) upon this charge.
8. That a Judgment be filed against the Defendant for the medical expenses for the victim, Brittany Duty, both past and present, as well as civil damages and punitive damages.
9. The Defendant shall not receive credit for time served on this charge.
10. This sentence shall run consecutive to the sentence imposed in Count One.
11. That all previous orders are incorporated herein as if set forth in their entirety.
12. The Court does hereby ORDER that Counsel for Defendant has a period of ten (10) days in which to file any objections to this Court's Order in writing, and if no objections are filed, then this Court's Order shall remain in full force and effect.
13. The Court orders that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a certified copy of this order to all counsel of record, and to the Probation Department.
